News & Changes

- The catalogue server has been updated and is now based on CET Designer 8.5. This update will mainly lead to minor catalogue download improvements.
- Stretching has been disabled for catalogue objects that are snapped together.

Bug fixes

- When we introduced Post processing in the last version, it caused the Camera View component to no longer show rendered images. This issue has now been solved, but the functionality has also changed slightly:

After placing a Camera View component, select the camera that you want to refer to, your render settings, and then click the Render image button. Once the rendering is finished, you will have to click to select it in the Render Queue window in order for the image to be displayed in the camera view. Repeat this step for each rendering that should be displayed in a camera view.

If you use any of the post processing effects in the render queue, the Camera View will update to reflect those changes in the image, and the post processing is saved with the drawing.*

All images in your drawing saved to

“C:\Users\\AppData\Local\Configura\” folder, unless you have manually changed the save location in the Control Panel.

- We have also fixed the issue that allowed images that were dragged from the render queue and dropped on the drawing area to have the same file name. Each image file now has a unique file name.
